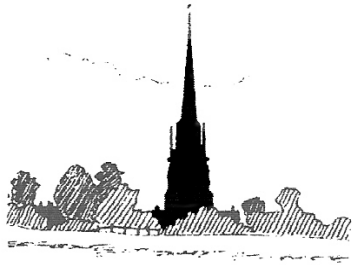

Sun Safety Policy

Policy statement

During the Month of Madness, we are aware of the importance of sun protection and want everyone to enjoy the sun safely. Sun safety will be promoted to improve understanding and provision to avoid the harmful effects of too much exposure to ultraviolet light.

The Parish Council encourages Volunteers and the Professionals to act as positive role models and set a good example by seeking out shade whenever possible and wearing suitable clothing.

Protection – Sun cream

It is recommended that children attending outdoor events should have their sun cream applied prior to arrival. Parish Council Volunteers can reapply sun cream for children who stay all day, as long as we have written permission from parent/guardians. This permission will be kept on the child's file. Children should bring in their own named sun cream.

Shade

Children will be encouraged to use the shaded area when appropriate.

Clothing

Children should be encouraged to wear clothes that provide good sun protection. In particular, to wear clothes covering sensitive areas such as shoulders and backs. A sun hat worn if appropriate.

Drinking Water

Bottled water should be **marked clearly** with the child's name.

Children will be encouraged to increase their water intake during activities in hot weather.
