

Works – Carriageway Retexturing – A422/B4525 Middleton Cheney Roundabout

Start date – 10th August 2018

Completion – 11th August 2018 (Weather Dependent)

Scheme type – Carriageway Retexturing

Traffic management - Road closure

Hours of work – 20:00-6:00



What we are doing/the benefits – This road has been selected for carriageway retexturing which will renew and restore the original design properties of the road surface with regard to the texture and skid resistance.

The works will take place on the A422/B4525 Roundabout itself.

When programming works we consider the impact on all road users and plan our works to minimise disruption. We do understand that the closure will be inconvenient but works can only be completed safely and efficiently with this in place. We hope any inconvenience will be tolerated for the duration of the works, as this scheme will significantly improve this route.

Please note that these works are dependent on good weather conditions

Traffic Management

To maintain the health and safety of the workforce and the public the works will be carried out under a road closure with a diversion route in place. A diversion will be in place at all times, red line being the road closure and the blue the diversion(see overleaf). Refer to roadworks.org

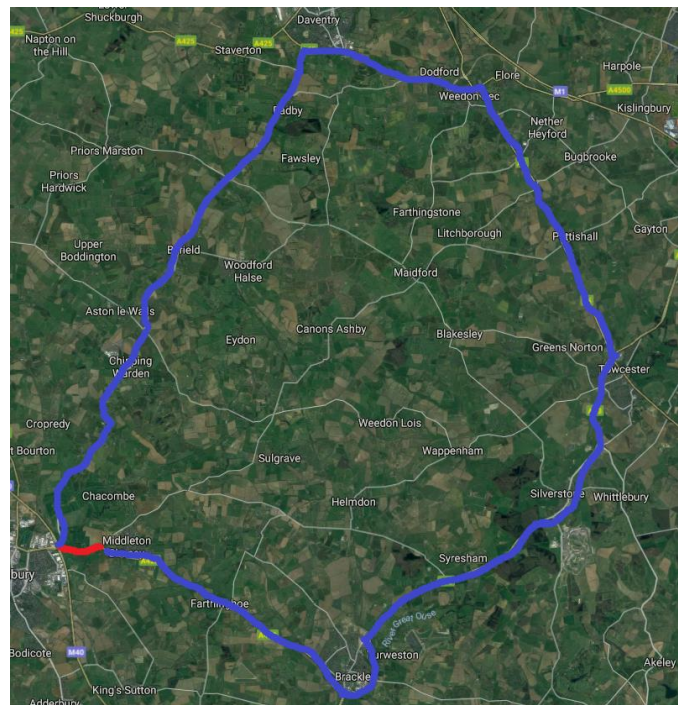
Information for residents and businesses

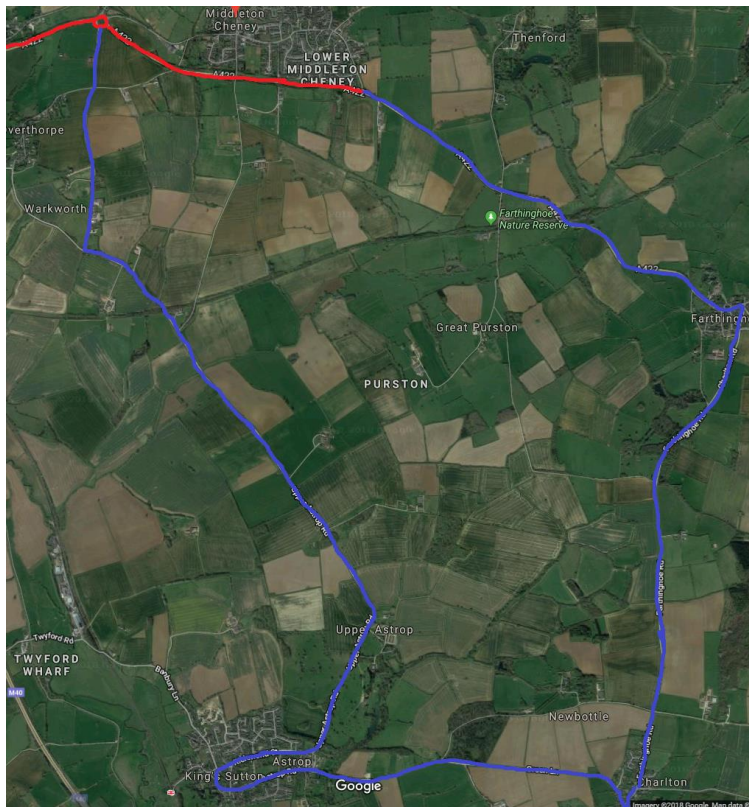
Access: Access for residents and businesses will be maintained at all times, although they will be escorted through the works by a pedestrian/traffic marshal.
