**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Northamptonshire County Council have made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit traffic from proceeding along those lengths of the various roads in Middleton Cheney as specified in the Schedule below.

**REASONS FOR RESTRICTION:** The restriction is required for safety during a Remembrance Parade.

**PERIOD OF CLOSURE:** The proposed Order will come into effect on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2019 and will continue in force for a period of one day. The restriction specified will have effect only at such times and to such an extent as is indicated by the display of signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

**EXPECTED DURATION:** It is expected that these roads will be restricted for one day.

**SCHEDULE**

(Lengths of roads to be closed)

Main Road, Middleton Cheney – from the junction of The Avenue to Queen Street.  
High Street, Middleton Cheney – from the junction of Main Road to Church Lane.  
Church Lane, Middleton Cheney – from the junction of High Street to All Saints Church.  
Queen Street, Middleton Cheney – from the junction of Church Lane to Mansion Hill.  
Astrop Road, Middleton Cheney – from the junction of Main Road to Barnett Road.

Diversion route – A422 and B4525 or Astrop Road and Middleton Cheney Road.
