

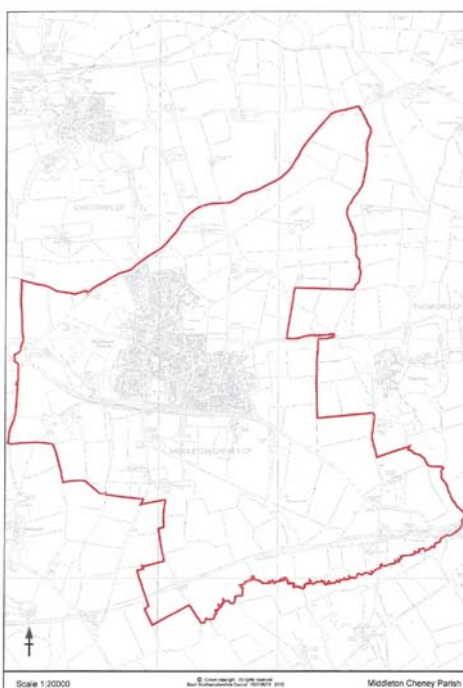


PUBLIC NOTICE

NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING (GENERAL) REGULATIONS 2012 DESIGNATION OF A NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA, MIDDLETON CHENEY

Notice is given that an application has been made by Middleton Cheney Parish Council for designation of a Neighbourhood Area under Section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

The purpose of the application is to enable the Parish Council to undertake neighbourhood planning, and in particular to prepare a Neighbourhood Plan, for the area covered by the Civil Parish of Middleton Cheney, as shown on the map below.



The entirety of the parish is considered to be the area most appropriate to be designated as a neighbourhood area for planning purposes, as it is a long established, well recognised and clearly defined area. Within the parish, the great majority of residents live in one nuclear settlement, which has a clear physical and social identity.

Middleton Cheney Parish Council is a 'relevant body' for the purposes of Section 61G of the 1990 Act, and is therefore qualified to undertake neighbourhood planning.

In accordance with Regulation 6 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, the application is now advertised for representations as to whether there is any reason why the District Council should not make the designation. Further information can be found at www.southnorthants.gov.uk.
